

Tobacco's Toll in Illinois

(Dec. 10, 2021)

<i>Adults who smoke</i>	12.7% (1,251,800)
<i>High school students who smoke</i>	4.7% (31,100)
<i>High school students who use e-cigarettes</i>	19.9%
<i>Death caused by smoking each year</i>	18,300
<i>Annual health care costs directly caused by smoking</i>	\$5.49 billion
<i>Proportion of cancer deaths attributable to smoking</i>	29.3%
<i>Residents' state and federal tax burden from smoking-caused government expenditures</i>	\$772 per household
<i>Estimated annual tobacco industry marketing in state</i>	\$203.3 million
