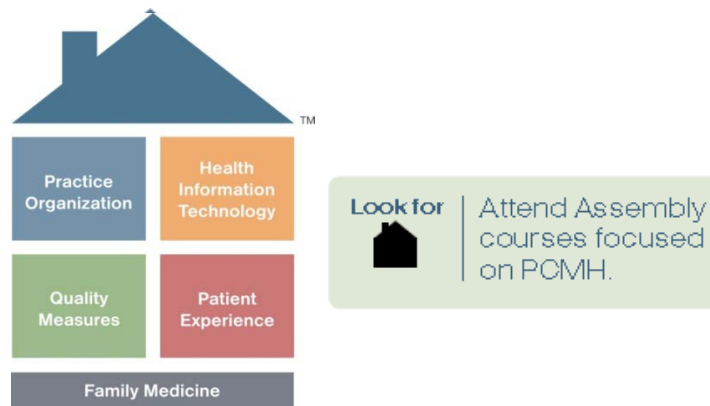

- Meet with office staff to see if anyone is willing to take a leadership role in change.
- Consider a brief retreat with key office staff to assess how your practice is going and what you might like to change.
- Read about the patient centered medical home to see what it might offer for you and your patients.
