Assists the president in organizing resident activities at IAFP meetings. Serve as the Illinois delegate to the AAFP's National Congress of Resident Members July 29 – 31, 2010 in Kansas City. The selected resident will represent Illinois', attend the business sessions and cast Illinois' votes at the Congress. A written report will be required to IAFP upon your return. **NOTE: Funding is NOT available in 2010 for travel expenses to National Conference. Travel would be at the expense of the resident or his/her program.*

President-elect will serve as President for the subsequent term (July 2011 to June 2012).

Other Requirements: Attend the 2010 Family Medicine Forum October 16 in Oak Brook. Can be called upon to represent Illinois residents at various opportunities or asked to serve as a backup to the resident president.
