## MEDICARE ACCESS AND CHIP REAUTHORIZATION ACT OF 2015—H.R. 2

## Key Features

- \* Repeals the flawed Medicare sustainable growth rate (SGR) permanently, effective immediately.
- ✤ Guarantees positive payment updates of 0.5% per year, for four and a half years (July 2015 through 2019), for all physicians participating in the Medicare program.
- Provides new medical liability protections for physicians participating in quality improvement programs.
- Current quality incentive and payment programs, such as PQRS, meaningful use, and VBM, are consolidated and streamlined into a single program.
  - The total financial risk to physician practices from penalties has been reduced to 8 percent compared to 13 percent under current law.
- ✤ Funding is provided for the development of physician quality measures.
  - o Physicians retain their preeminent role in developing quality standards.
- Physicians practicing in a recognized patient centered medical home or in any other alternative payment model (APM) recognized by the Secretary, will receive a 5 percent bonus in years 2019 to 2024.
  - Physician participation in an APM is voluntary.
  - Starting in 2026 and beyond, physicians in APMs qualify for a 0.75 percent update; all others will receive a 0.25 percent annual update.
- \$100 million is provided to assist small physician practices participate in APMs or the new feefor-service incentive program, for years 2016 to 2020.
- ✤ The fee-for-service payment system is retained.
- \* Extends funding for the Children's Health Insurance Program for two years.
- Extends the Teaching Health Center Graduate Medical Education (THCGME) program for two additional years.
- ♦ Extends funding for Community Health Centers for two years.
- \* Extends funding for the National Health Service Corps for two years.
