

Resolution of Condolence

Paul A. Kinsinger, MD

WHEREAS, Paul A. Kinsinger, MD, was a beloved family physician in his community of Washington, IL, where he practiced with his brother, Lee Kinsinger, MD, at Illini Family Medicine for 25 years, and

WHEREAS, Dr. Kinsinger also served his community in a wider scope as medical director of Methodist Medical Center Hospice, Rosewood Nursing Home, Helping Hands Home Health, and Transitions Hospice in the Peoria area, and

WHEREAS, Dr. Kinsinger was an inexhaustible “idea” man, whose creative energies could enliven any audience, and developed notoriety for his invention of Dr. Paul’s Piggy Paste, a product to clear unsightly toe nails; for development of a ring road around the community and expansion of bike trails; and

WHEREAS, Dr. Kinsinger’s trademark response to “How are you?” was a cheerful, “Incredible!” no matter his situation; and

WHEREAS, Dr. Kinsinger joined the AAFP and Illinois chapter as a medical student, graduating from University of Illinois at Chicago in 1986 with his MD, and served his family medicine residency at Baylor University in Houston before a brief jaunt to Seattle and then a return to Washington; and

WHEREAS, Dr. Kinsinger was a great husband, father, uncle, sibling in the Kinsinger/Ackerman families, teaching the next generation golf, sharing his strong faith with them and others; and

WHEREAS, Dr. Kinsinger died Feb. 20, 2016 after a one-year battle with aggressive brain cancer;

WHEREAS, the Illinois chapter submitted a similar Resolution to the 2016 American Academy of Family Physicians Congress of Delegates, September 19-21, 2016; therefore be it
