WHEREAS, Paul Wesley Sunderland was born March 19, 1919, in Fisher, Illinois, graduated from Fisher High School, received his Bachelor of Science degree from University of Illinois at Champaign-Urbana, then graduated in 1942 from University of Illinois College of Medicine at Chicago;

WHEREAS, he completed a medical internship at the U.S. Naval Academy at Annapolis, Md., while serving with the U.S. Navy from June 1942 to July 1947;

WHEREAS, Paul was a family physician in private practice for 47 years in Gibson City and Fisher where he provided patient care;

WHEREAS, he was an AAFP member from 1949 until he retired in 1994 and had been an AAFP Diplomate since 1972;

WHEREAS, Dr. Sunderland played an active role in establishing the Gibson Community Hospital which opened in 1952 and was the first inductee into its Hall of Fame, aptly named the Sunderland Society;

WHEREAS, Paul actively recruited fellow physicians throughout his time in practice which was one of his most important contributions to the hospital's success;

WHEREAS, Dr. Sunderland lived a life of community service as a faithful member of First Presbyterian Church and its choir; founding board member of Gibson Area Hospital Foundation; member of Gibson City Board of Education; co-founder of Gibson Area Music Foundation and founder of Gibson Area House Rehab Foundation;

WHEREAS, he was recognized as an important member of the community when he was inducted into Fisher High School's Hall of Fame and also named Citizen of the Year for Gibson City;

WHEREAS, Paul W. Sunderland, M.D., 95, died Friday, January 16, 2015, be it
