FMIG leaders are encouraged to apply.

The job description for the student officer position is as follows:

President-elect: Assists the president in organizing student activities. Serve as the Illinois delegate to the AAFP's National Congress of Student Members July 29 – 31, 2010 in Kansas City.* The selected student will represent Illinois' student interests, attend the business sessions and cast Illinois' votes at the National Conference. A written report will be required to IAFP upon your return.

President-elect will serve as President for the subsequent term (July 2011 to June 2012).
