Family Medicine Midwest is a 12-state collaboration dedicated to building a strong family medicine workforce to provide high-quality, comprehensive care to the people of our region. We are dedicated to attracting, keeping and developing outstanding family physicians for the future. The Family Medicine Midwest Foundation, a 501 (c) 3 organization, is an established leader in collaborative family medicine workforce development.

The centerpiece of the Family Medicine Midwest Foundation is an annual conference. This three-day event attracts faculty, resident and medical students from Midwest states to:

- Attract and inspire medical students to choose Midwest Family Medicine Residency Programs
- Provide a format for residents to present, to learn from each other and from faculty presenters, and find their family medicine career path
- Showcase the amazing variety of career opportunities in family medicine
- Provide a platform to share innovative ideas, best practices and build regional networks dedicated to improving the health of all patients, tackling many of today's most daunting public health challenges.

We've held seven successful Family Medicine Midwest Conferences:

By tracking the Match results of past student attendees, we have established a track record of success:

- Of the 41 attendees from FM Midwest 2012 who graduated in 2013, 39 matched into family medicine residency programs.
- Of 61 FMM Midwest attendees in the 2014 Match, 42 are in family medicine residency programs.
- Of 72 FM Midwest attendees in the 2015 Match 43 are in family medicine (60%) and 31 of them are in Midwest programs.
- 50 of 78 graduates who attended any of the first four Family Medicine Midwest Conferences matched into Family Medicine in 2016. Thirty of them are staying in the Midwest.
- Of 54 conference attendees in the 2017 Match, 31 matched into family medicine and 25 of them to Midwest residency programs.
- With 96 FMM attendees graduating in 2018 confirmed, 48 (50%) matched into family medicine, and 33 of those chose Midwest residency programs.
- 43 out of 60 (72%) of FMM scholarship students matched into family medicine in 2019, with 26 in the Midwest!

Student Scholarships Fuel Family Medicine Midwest

Family Medicine Midwest provides vital scholarship support for students, including free registration, and financial support towards travel and hotel expenses. For most of our student attendees, these scholarships make it possible for them to attend, and be inspired by an event they would have otherwise missed. Scholarships are tailored to the travel needs of students, depending on the location of their medical school.
