This year, the total number of NRMP Match participants matching into family medicine was 4,493, up 158 from the 4,335 in 2020. 2020 was the first year that there was not an American Osteopathic Association match as U.S. graduate medical education programs transitioned to single accreditation through the Accreditation Council on Graduate Medical Education.
