

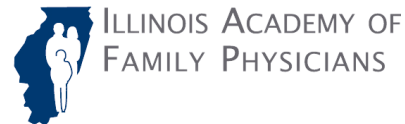

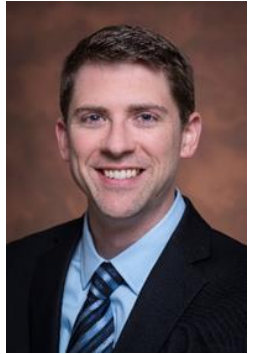
## Summer Update
